

THE ART PEACE PROJECT



As part of a cooperation between Ivan Franko National University of Lviv (Ukraine), Jagiellonian University of Krakow (Poland) and Hamburg University (Germany) a project called *Performing Conflict – Spirals of Dialogue* will be held in **Lviv, 06th – 11th of June 2017**.

The aim of the program is to develop shared democratic values through international exchange. The group will consist of five students from each university. The main activity, while exploring the city and its conflict laden places as well as our own (hi)stories, will be to reflect on this experience artistically, in the form of performances. The results will be presented in a performance tour and documented by film and photography.

This workshop is rooted in the Art Peace Project, an initiative of Hamburg University that aims at producing and reflecting on art as an effective way of getting people to communicate about important issues.
